


THE UNIVERSITY LIBRARY


Growth of Book Collection over the Years

The book collection is growing day by day. The growth of book collection over the years can be seen in the figure.




Growth of Periodicals (Print) Collection over the Years

Though not large in number, the print periodicals are also important resource in the Library for general reading and research.




Growth of Online Journal Collection over the Years
